World Fisheries Day

biota of major rivers in Pakistan. Last speaker of the Day-1 was Mr. Waqar Hussain Research Officer PCRWR, Islamabad. He gave a talk on arsenic contamination in ground water of Punjab province, its implications on health and required measures to make situation better. Faculty members, Masters, MPhil and PhD students from Department of Chemistry and from various other departments participated in the workshop. The first day of the workshop ended on souvenirs distribution.



On the second day of training workshop Mr. Waqar Hussain (Research Officer, PCRWR Lahore) discussed quality control requirements of a basic water quality laboratory. Ms Saiqa Imran (SRO, NWQL, PCRWR Islamabad) presented basic quality parameters of water, its impact on health and analytical requirements for standardized water. Ms. Mufeezah Ahsan, ASO, demonstrated the process of water sampling from various sources, field-testing, preservation, storage and transportation of sample. She also demonstrated the testing for microbiology using field testing kits and membrane filtration method to the groups of students. Mr. Mushtaq, Lab Technician, PCRWR, Islamabad, demonstrated field testing for basic physico-chemical parameters (pH, EC, TDS) to the groups of students and faculty. Ms Saiqa Imran, SRO NWQL, demonstrated field-testing for Arsenic (Protocols-Exercise) (Merck kit and PCRWR kit) to the group of trainees. Dr. Hifza



Rasheed (Director, NWQL, PCRWR, Islamabad) acknowledged the efforts of organizers of the event and thanked the Vice chancellor and Chemistry Department of GCWUF for conduction of collaborative two day training.
